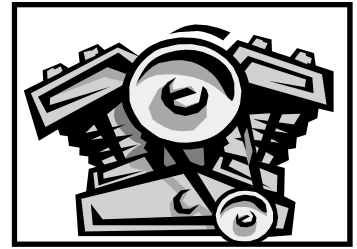

The scholarship fund will be covered in more detail in a future newsletter.

In 2000, Mother Nature wasn't very cooperative and the swap meet had to be cancelled by noon and subsequently did not make much money. In 2001 the venue for the swap meet was moved to the Montrose County Fairgrounds and will once again be held there this year. In 2002 the swap meet continued to grow with a very popular bake sale and concessions being added.

The participation at the swap meet continues to increase every year and has brought car enthusiasts from all over the region including Senator Ben Nighthorse Campbell who is an avid Harley rider and a "Car Guy".

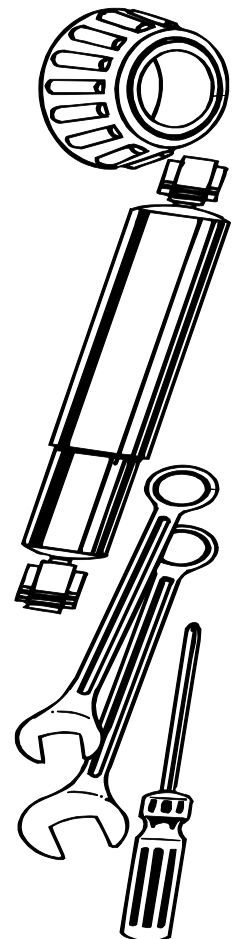
