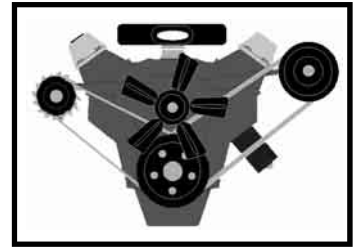

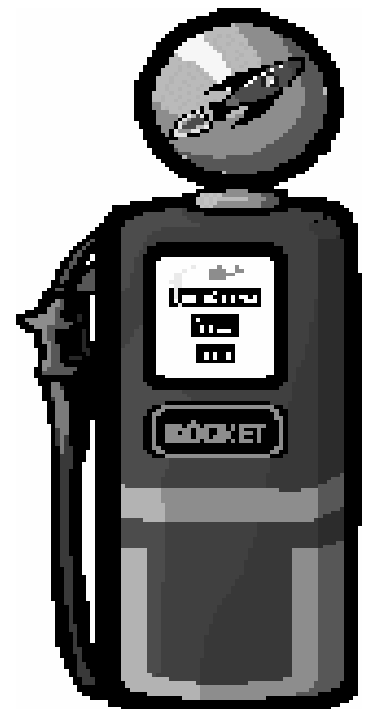
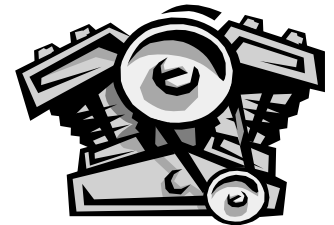

MORE THAN JUST A CAR CLUB

The Swap Meet and the Car, Rod and Truck Show are the Black Canyon Classics Car Club's two biggest events of the year. Beyond public enjoyment of our hobby is the Club's commitment to fulfilling civic needs.

The first event of the year is the BCCCC Swap Meet held in May that donates 100% of its proceeds to fund the Student Scholarship Fund. The program was established in 1999 and awards a minimum of 2 scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to Montrose, Delta or Ouray students who are enrolling in a post secondary education program in the automotive technology field. This includes but is not limited to auto mechanics and/or auto body repair. Scholarship applications are available starting April 1st through June 15th. The BCCCC Scholarship Committee reviews the applications, interviews the applicants and announces the recipients at the annual Car, Rod and Truck show in July. Past students have attended schools throughout Colorado, Wyoming and Arizona.

The Black Canyon Classic Car, Rod and Truck Show, a 3 day event held in July in Montrose, shares its proceeds two ways. Approximately 20% is used to fund the Student Scholarship Fund and the remaining 80% is donated to a local civic group. This year's recipient is the Community Dental Clinic. This not for profit organization was established September 9, 1999 by concerned dentists and citizens to address the lack of Medicaid dental providers for the Western Slope. The Community Dental Clinic is currently only one of three Medicaid providers on the Western Slope accepting new patients. The other two clinics located in Grand Junction and Glenwood Springs have geographic residency requirements. The Community Dental Clinic in Montrose cover the remainder of the Western Slope and treats Medicaid eligible children and young mothers under the age of 21. In 1999 the Community Dental Clinic started with 1 treatment room and 1 part time dentist. Today there are 3 treatment rooms, 1 full time dentist, 1 part time dentist, 2 part time hygienists and 3 dental assistants. They currently treat over 2000 patients. One of the main reasons the Clinic is able to keep its doors open is they operate rent and utility free and rely on donations of equipment and resources. So this year at the Car, Rod and Truck Show when you visit their booth to vote for the "Peoples Choice Award", take time to visit with these folks, see their display, listen to their stories and appreciate what a fantastic service they provide for our community.

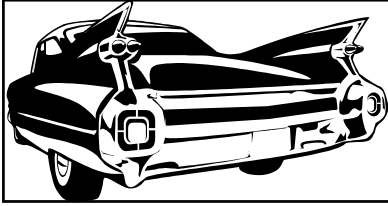

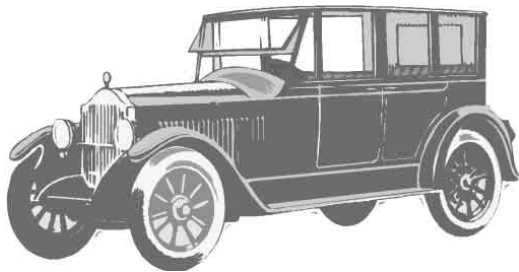
